### Message from our Executive Principal

### Dear Parents/Guardians

I cannot believe we are already at the end of the first half of the Autumn term, it seems only yesterday we started the new year! It is, as always, a pleasure to spend time in the classrooms with the children, they have been doing some wonderful work across all areas and we cannot wait to share this with you at our Parent Consultation afternoon/evening on 6th and 7th **November.** If you have not returned your reply slip confirming the day and time you would like to attend, please can you do this as soon as possible.

We will also be holding a **Phonics Parent Workshop** for Nursey, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 parents on 21st **November.** Any Year 2 child that did not achieve the benchmark for phonics at the end of Year 1, will be screened in June next year again, as required by the DFE. Although this seems a long time away, the time does go very quickly and this evening will allow you to see what is required of your child during the screening, as well as give you good tips on the sounds and the blending techniques needed.

I would like to thank all parents and relatives that came to our annual Harvest Festival in support of the children, as well as thank you for the generous donations we were able to pass on to the church to distribute to the homeless in Bedford. I must say a special thank you to Miss Rice for her organisation of the event, as well as all staff who have worked with the children to get them ready. Our extension of the medical room and disabled toilet is nearly finished and we hope this will be fully operational, when we return.


I would like to thank you again for your continued support and wish you, your son/daughter and staff a wonderful half term.

Parenting programmes enable parents to build on what they already know and to do the best for their children. They do this by providing opportunities for parents to gain new knowledge, skills and confidence to support their children and strengthen relationships within the family. Term 1 - 75 days Term 2 – 61 days Term 3 - 59 days = 195 days.

Pupil contact will amount to 190 of the 195 days. School will be closed on four of the 195 days. These four days will enable teacher training to take place in accordance with Teachers' Conditions of Service.

Training days set as follows: Monday 2 September 2019, Tuesday 3 September 2019, Friday 29 November 2019, Monday 20 April 2020, plus 4 twilight sessions.
